As parents, coaches and players, we all get emotional during games because we want our team to succeed. As a group, we need to all be on the same team on how we do and how we don't express these emotions.

Expectations during games:

- Applause during introduction of players, coaches and officials.
- Accept all decisions of officials.
- Fans cheer in a positive manner.
- Handshakes between participants and coaches at the end of the game, regardless of outcome.
- Treat competition as an opportunity to grow as a team and as individual players.
- Coaches and players search out opposing participants to recognize them for outstanding performance or coaching.
- Applause at the end of a game for performances by all participants.
- Everyone showing concern for an injured player, regardless of team.
- Encouraging surrounding people to display only sportsmanlike conduct.
- Please refrain from coaching or officiating from the sidelines.

Additional expectations at games, practices, at school and outside of school:

- Do not bully other players, students, parents or coaches
- Refrain from bad language
- Refrain from gossip
